The children enjoyed dressing up as their favourite book characters on World Book Day.

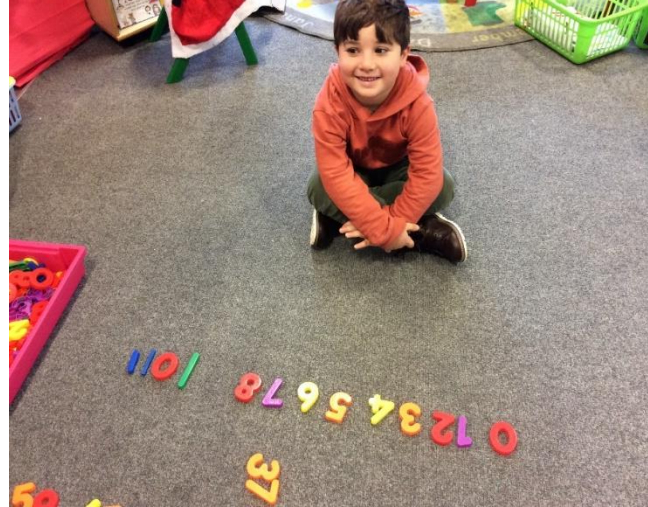


King's coronation
