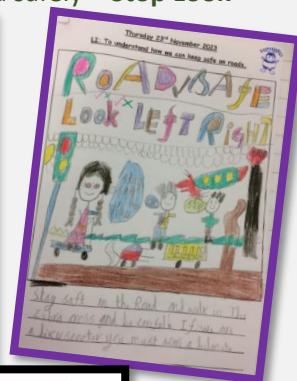
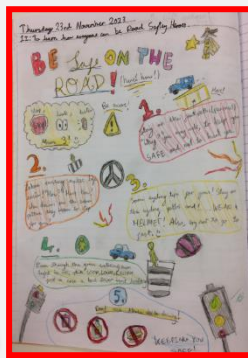

The post box will be available from **4th of December** outside Willow Hall, for children to post their Christmas cards.



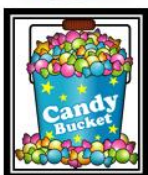
Christmas Accessory Day Wednesday 13th December
