

Message from the Headteacher

If your child is eligible to start Nursery in September 2024, please remember to complete the application form, which is available from the school office and submit this as soon as possible. Nursery places will be allocated from March 2024. We also offer limited full-time places for eligible families, please inform us if you are interested in putting your application forward for these spaces.

Mrs Simpson the Deputy Headteacher, spoke to all the KS2 children during last Friday's assembly about: keeping yourself safe-online; how to behave online and what to do if you are worried. Please make sure when children access devices they are not alone in a room, but based somewhere where adults can see them. Also, from time to time, please talk to them about the importance of speaking to a trusted adult if they come across anything online, that is causing them concern.

An external consultant visited Vicar's Green last Wednesday, and spent the day speaking to various subject leaders and pupils to assess the quality of the curriculum on offer. Through the partial deep dives in History, Computing, Geography, Art, DT, and Science, she concluded that subject leaders were proactive and lead their subjects with a clear vision. Teachers knew where the gaps in knowledge were and are working securing these. We now need to focus on developing children's subject specific vocabulary and the ability to make links across the curriculum.

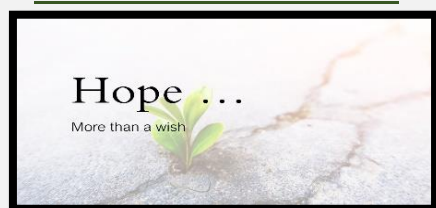
Announcements

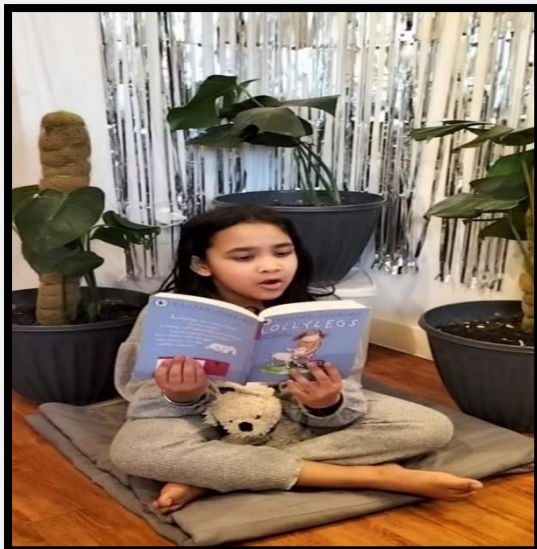

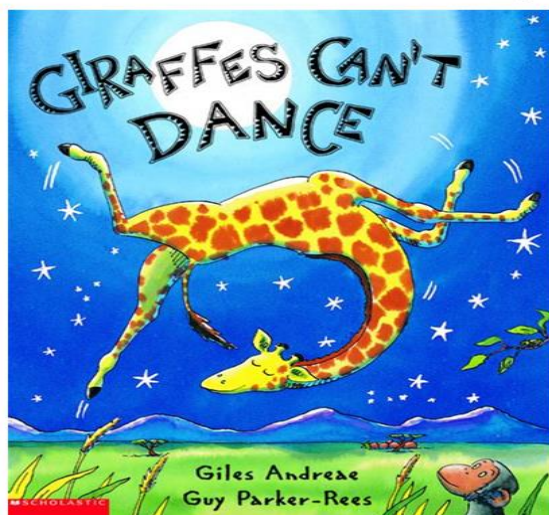
