Message from the Headteacher

To develop pupils' ability to express their thoughts and ideas coherently, the school has embraced oracy as a priority this year. The purpose of this initiative is to encourage children to be effective communicators through oracy projects that feature skills such as storytelling, debating and presenting. Good oracy skills support wider literacy skills; improvement in oracy is also linked to improvements in reading, writing, and overall attainment. Children are practicing these skills during class discussions and are learning to instigate, build and challenge to move conversation forward.

We have organised a range of exciting curriculum events and workshops for pupils, but as you are aware, these can be quite expensive and it is not possible to cover the cost from the school budget. Please may I request you to make timely payments so we can continue to enrich the curriculum for our pupils.

Mornings can be a busy time and quite rushed. So that the children have a calm start to the day, it is often a good idea to organise the items they need to bring to school the night before. 
Anti – Bullying Week





