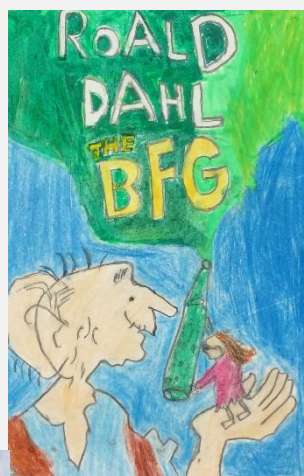
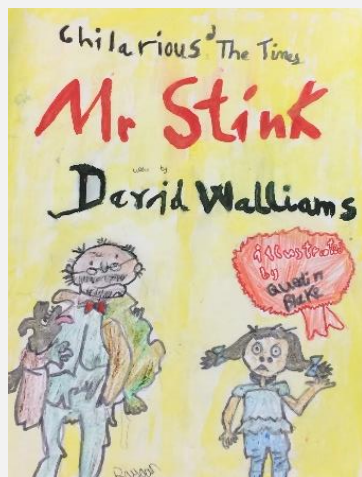

## Scholastic Book Fair Competition



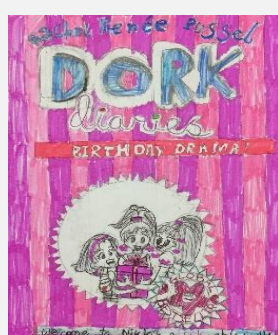
For homework last week, all children were invited to design a poster of their choice, in order to win a £5 Scholastic gift voucher.
